- Two special rooms with accessible bathrooms/roll-in showers available on an hourly sign-up basis
- Laundry facilities; bring detergent
- Rollaway bed available upon request
- Refrigerators in kitchen and dining hall for medications
- Meals served buffet style in the dining hall
- Snacks, juice and fruit available all day
