Pray for the Salvadoran therapists' and mechanics' training in proper wheelchair seating and fitting.	12 Thank the Lord for the many prisoners around the United States who restore the chairs prior to the outreach. Pray also for the chair corps volunteers who collect wheelchairs.	13 This is our last day fitting wheelchairs. Pray that everyone has been wonderfully served, and that they know it is God's desire to show them His love and compassion.	14 Today the team will fly home. Pray for safe travels and a smooth time through customs. Continue to pray for good health.
